These instructions are written in the required style. All abstracts must be written in English. Only Word (.doc or .docx) files are accepted.

Each abstract should consist of one page. The width and height of the field without margins should be 125 mm by 185 mm, respectively. The title, author list and affiliations should be centred. Text, acknowledgments and references should be justified. The abstract should contain only text, formula and tables. References are referred to as [1] in the text and should be listed at the very end.

Leave a blank line between the title and the author list, between the author list and the affiliations, between the affiliations and the e-mail of the presenting author, between the keywords and the first line of the text, between the text and acknowledgments and between acknowledgments and references.

The text should be written in Times New Roman, 10pt at single line spacing. Formulas and special characters can be used, but special care should be taken that these do not change the line spacing.

Do not use chapter headings and do not leave a line between different paragraphs, but use an indentation of 5 mm at the beginning of each new paragraph.

Acknowledgments should be written in Times New Roman, 9pt, and follow the text. References should be written in Times New Roman, 9pt, and listed in sequence of

appearance [2,3].

Make sure the content is properly arranged so that optimal use of 1 page space is guaranteed.
